Students are already stressed with their academic load, trying to maintain a social life, and college admissions. And this

year's pandemic brings an additional level of stress, which can wreak havoc on students. However few precautions can help the students to cope with all the stress

- 1. Exercise-Exercise is a \_provenand recommended stress reliever because it reduces levels of the stress hormone. cortisol, and releases feel-good chemicals like endorphins. This not only can help manage stress but research indicates a clear correlation between physical activity and academic performance.
- 2- Meditation-For students who are learning remotely this year, making a conscious decision to put their phone away during class will be very real. That's where meditation can help with stress and focus. Research shows that those who practice meditation have more activity in their prefrontal cortex — the region of the brain that deals with decision making, social behavior, and focus.
- 3- Eating Nutritious Food-Students learning remotely will

no longer have the support of their college cafeteria to help them choose nutritious meals. But eating right, like whole, fibrous foods, is vital for academic performance. This is especially true in stressful times when it can be even more difficult to choose healthy foods because poor eating habits and stress often go hand in hand.

- 4- Spend time outside-Undoubtedly one of the most challenging parts of the pandemic is being stuck at home, and that isolation may lead to unhealthy habits like poor diet or overeating. But spending time outside can make a huge difference as research indicates a link between the outdoors and academic performance.
- 5- Talk to Friends-One of the most important components of school is social interaction. Multiple studies show that when we're surrounded by friends we have a more optimistic view on life, which may help us more easily overcome challenges.
