Krishi & Pashu Mela

Faculty of Agriculture, Bhagwant University organized 'Krishi & Pashu Mela' on 18th February, 2017 in the University Campus, Ajmer. The fair was inaugurated by the Chief guest - Dr. Gopal Lal (Director, NRCSS, Tabiji, Ajmer) and Special Guests Dr. V. K. Sharma (Deputy Director (Agri.), Govt. of Rajasthan) and Dr. Sunil Ghiya (Veterinary Expert).

The Fair was attended by the Registrar, Assistant Registrar, Dean of International Affairs, Dean of Academics, Assistant Director, Administrative Officer, Agriculture faculty members, 500 students of B.Sc.
